This house has been in operation for 85 years and is continuing assisting women who have been traumatized by violent crimes. They collaborate with the Department of Social Services. They try to make it a home to




Judge Quan was hit for \$50 for forgetting this year's Rotary Motto "Rotary Serving Humanity" an easy one to remember.
