

ECPD Officer Mike Boston, CUHSD School Resource Officer. Officer Boston discussed the District's emergency situation response plan called ALICE - alert, lockdown, inform, counter and evacuate. He discussed the District's emergency communications network, which is a web-based app entitled Catapult EMS. It allows everyone involved in the incident to report in real time to keep everyone advised on what is happening during an incident. He indicated that there is no cookie-cutter way to handle a specific emergency situation and that all students and teachers involved need to focus on (1) interrupting the assailant's mission and (2) evacuating to safety as quickly and efficiently as possible.
