Pledge, Prayer and Song

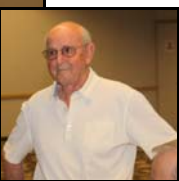

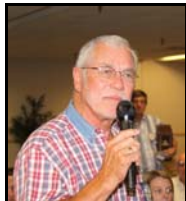
back and forth for being recognized as "the most efficient Court in the State" ! Chris paid \$50 and Jose \$100. Thanks Gentlemen for making us proud!
